FAMILY AND KINSHIP IN EAST LONDON - BETHNAL GREEN SURVEY  
(CHILDREN)

HISTORY

The pack contained 731 multi-punched cards which agrees with the total given in the book. The example schedules used in reconstructing the codebook were those for case numbers 0218, 0245, 0725, 0726, 0838 and 1508 since these appeared to offer the widest selection of responses to information regarding the children of the subject.

The first run of the conversion program produced two errors: one, a multi-punch in the third digit of the four column case-number field for family member number 24 of case 17 2 and the other, an invalid combination of punches in column 7 (marital status and sex coding of subject) of case-number 2050 for family member number 22. The first error was corrected by reference to other cards having three of the same digits in the case-number field and the same coding for column 21 (number of children) and the second, by reference to the other family member number cards for case-number 2050, where the common subject information was repeated.

The original 21 multi-punched columns were expanded to 32 in the conversion process to single punched card images and the resulting file was then recorded to combine codes, eliminate zone punches and to alter code values to produce a more convenient coding frame.

## CODEBOOK

The coding structure for the common subject information at the beginning of the record was inferred from the subject's codebook and reference to the example schedules. That for the remaining columns, except those still in question, was drawn up by comparing sub-totals with those in the "working papers". There remain just 6 columns for which the coding frame has not been discovered.

The first set of three of these, columns 13 to 15, has the "familiar" appearance of a "birth order" coding, with column 13 applicable to all children of the subject and columns 14 and 15 applicable only to female and male children respectively, from a comparison with the sub-totals in column 10 (sex of child). The second set of three columns, 18 to 20, again has a complete range of codes, with column 19 applicable to female children only and, column 20 to male children - could be "birth order" but why coded twice?-
