Please note that the datafiles pertaining to Bristol and Norwich contain data that is of a slightly different structure to the other files. The occupational coding remains intact, but other variables may be ambiguous.

Below is an spss syntax file for users of the raw ASCII data. It should both import each datafile specified in the file handle command, and export an spss portable file, also user specified.

DIRECTORIES DATABASE, 1772-87:  
URBAN OCCUPATIONS IN BRITAIN IN THE EARLY  
INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION

"Knowledge is of two kinds. We know a subject ourselves - or we know where we can find information upon it." So stated Dr Johnson in 1775, in characteristically thumping style [1]. His remark drew attention to the notable growth of standard reference works in the course of the eighteenth century. Such compilations attempted to classify and make available in standardised format a voluminous mass of "useful information". Omniscience was impossible, but access to reference books was becoming easy for the literate - who by the eighteenth century constituted a sizeable and still growing phalanx.

Local town directories were produced in increasing numbers from the 1760s onwards and were viewed as essential handbooks to urban life [2]. They were ad hoc works, generally providing listings of leading local inhabitants, with their names, addresses and occupations. So constituted, they offered a starting point for further investigation, for visitors and residents alike. However, these were not yet a standardised and mass-produced genre, so there was much diversity in their quality and contents.

Historians have used these sources in a variety of ways, often with great caution. It is apparent - but also worth stressing again - that the directories did not constitute anything like a full census of employment. They covered only a small proportion of the local population and the information they contained was not always accurate or fully up-to-date. Indeed, the directory compilers often solicited corrections and amendments, for publication in later editions.[3]

These sources, however, derive their importance from what they were, not from what they might have been. It is of interest in itself to know, for example, which towns had local directories and when; to survey the number of residents listed and to identify their range of stated occupations; and to make a comparative assessment of the data relating to different directories, different towns, and different occupational groups.

The project on "Urban Occupations in Britain in the Early Industrial Revolution [ESRC FOO/23/2077: 1983-85] set out to do just that.[4] The sources were surveyed systematically - as they were constituted in their own right - and thereby made available for critical evaluation.

Sources were selected from all large urban centres with early listings. That is to say, one directory (or relevant section from a directory) was analysed for every urban centre for which such a local publication was

produced either in the 1770s or 1780s. In some cases, the selection was simple, as only one such volume was available. Where there were many (as in the case of London or Birmingham), a substantial edition from an appropriate date was chosen. The range of towns investigated was as wide as possible within the British Isles, defined only by the existence of relevant sources. Most of the early directories served the larger urban communities, although not all big cities had them. In addition, a few smaller places were also included, to add to the range of urban centres in the survey. In all the timespan covered was a relatively compact period of fifteen years from 1772 to 1787

Individual volumes were identified in the invaluable directories of directories, edited by Goss and Norton respectively [5]. In addition, three further published listings were chosen for the leading Scottish and Irish cities. Copies of these sources either in the original or in facsimile editions are held in the excellent collection of directories in the University of London's Institute of Historical Research, as well as in the British Library, the Guildhall Library London, and in a number of provincial libraries [6].

In chronological sequence, the sixteen directories (or sections of directories) that were used for the creation of a computerised database are as follows

Urban centres in the survey thus include three capital cities London, Dublin, Edinburgh, four great ports Bristol, Glasgow, Liverpool, Newcastle upon Tyne, two county capitals Shrewsbury and Winchester, one dockyard town Portsmouth, one small port and resort Southampton, and one major resort Bath The quality of these directories as sources varied considerably, but, between them, they covered a wide range of urban communities For convenience, the directories were numbered and coded alphabetically

Information in the directories was transferred onto computer file, following procedures established in the ESRC "Pilot Study of Occupational Data in the Early Town Directories" [HR/8053]. The data were grouped into

11 fixed fields in 132 columns, as indicated in Appendix I below

Each entry began with three codes, which recorded the nature and date of the source and the town to which it referred, for full identification when sorting. Subsequent fields indicated respectively the surname, first name(s), address, and occupation of the individual, and any other miscellaneous information. For the purposes of this Project, the address was given in full, showing street name as specified, prefaced by the house number, if given. (In the Pilot Study, the addresses were coded into a parish code, so that directory addresses could be compared with those in Poll Book listings that gave parish of residence only. That was not needed, however, when looking at directories on their own.)

One set of information - relating to occupations - was so detailed and diverse in presentation that it required coding for systematic study. To maximise flexibility and to minimise inconsistencies, an extended version of a standard classification was adopted. It was amplified from the system originally proposed by Charles Booth in the later nineteenth century and subsequently reworked by W A Armstrong [7]. Each occupation was given a threefold identification code: firstly under a general sector of the economy, and secondly, under a specific trade, industry, or profession, within each sector. That followed the Booth/Armstrong system. A third coding was then

added in order to identify the occupation precisely as listed in the original source.

That additional information remains crucial. It adds flexibility into the system, retaining the full range of detailed occupational labels and making it possible, if need be, to amend the classification within the file. Hence this additional information is now generally accepted as an essential extension to the twofold coding in Booth/Armstrong. (Additional columns were also available here for the recording of multiple occupations).

For reference here, the following table shows the main categories and sub-categories in the Booth/Armstrong classification:[8]

Furthermore, four final fields recorded each individual's gender, and (where indicated) his or her social status, whether the entry referred to a firm or not, and whether or not an industrial address was also listed in addition to the domestic residence

This extensive array of data was thus grouped systematically into 11 fields. It entailed some slight modification to the fields adopted in the Pilot.

Study.[9] All the information was entered interactively on a terminal linked to the Royal Holloway & Bedford New College mainframe computer, a Digital VAX 11/780. The database was then examined for a variety of purposes, showing the results in written, statistical, and graphical form; and a pilot exercise in computer mapping (of the Shrewsbury directory) as undertaken with the use of a digitising table.[10]

All in all, the total number of line-entries was as follows:

Ultimately, the early Directories provide extensive and thought-provoking information - rather than perfect data. But therein constitutes the analytical challenge for urban historians.
