SN 3654: Mathematical Women in the British Isles, 1878-1940

Introduction

The data sets that comprise this study outline the position and role of women in British mathematics between the years 1878 and 1940. In particular, they present data concerning access to training and career structures within mathematics and explore the nature of female involvement in this subject. The data set is drawn from the university calendars held by the British Library and, where this is incomplete, the archives of particular universities.
