P1888: National study of the Lottery and other gambling activities

This document provides detail of the edit specification used by NatCen's Operations Department staff to edit and clean the 1999 self-completion data.

Below are the edit instructions (expressed for the most part in words rather than column numbers) for the questionnaire. Please get in touch if they need clarifying.

Question A1:

The answers here should be consistent with those given at B2 and B3. That is, if a respondent says that they have done an activity in the last 7 days (at B2 or B3) they should also say that they have done that activity in the last 12 months (at A1). And, conversely, if they say they have *not* done an activity in the last 12 months, they cannot have done it in the last 7 days:

For example, if $qb2_1a = 1$, then qa1a must = 1.¹ And, if qa1a = 2, then $qb2_1a$ must = 2.

This is true for each activity. The activities 'match up' between A1 and B2/B3 as follows:

QA1a – activity 1 QA1b – activity 2 QA1c – activity 5 QA1d – activity 3 QA1e – activity 3 QA1f – activity 4 QA1f – activity 6 QA1g – activity 7 QA1h – activity 7 QA1i – activity 8 QA1j – activity 9 QA1j – activity 10 QA1k – activity 11 QA1I – activity 12

Question B1:

Please check that the date is feasible (within the fieldwork period)

Questions B2c & B3c:

Report records where expenditure is more than £100.

Question B4:

If a respondent has not done any gambling activities at all in the last 7 days (i.e. B2a and B3a are **all** code 2s) then it if not possible for them to 'typically' spend less. Therefore, B4 cannot = 3.

¹ This corresponds to the variable names on the archived dataset. For the rest of the edit instructions, the question numbers match the question numbers and sections in the self-completion questionnaire.

Question B5a:

If B5a = 1 then there must be at least one 'yes' (code 1) at activities 8 or 9 or 10 or 12 in the last 7 days (at B3a).

Question B6a:

If B6a = 1 then at least one of the following must be true: B2 Activity 2d = 10B2 Activity 4d = 8B3 Activity 6d = 12B3 Activity 8d = 4B3 Activity 9d = 4B3 Activity 10d = 4.

Question B6d:

If B6d = 2 then D8a must = code 1.

Section D:

D2 - code 5 is an exclusive code. D5b - code 14 is an exclusive code. D13 - code 1 is an exclusive code.

Finally, obviously, sex and age must match with the household questionnaire data for each respondent. And, the codes for the current status and job of the HIH should also match with the answers to the household questionanire (if you need more clarification of this matching, please let the research team know).
