How long will it take?

The focus group will last about 90 minutes. The first 5 minutes will be devoted to reviewing and signing a consent form which lists your rights as a participant and to answer any other questions you might have before we begin. You may also request a copy of the consent form in advance of our meeting.

Participants will also be required to fill out a questionnaire after the focus group session.

What happens to the video files and written transcripts?

You will be assigned a participant ID number so your contact details will never be kept with the video or transcript files.

All files will be kept in a password-protected file on a password-protected computer. Files will not be sent by e-mail, only on password-protected data sticks and by registered post.

Transcribers will be required to sign documentation binding them legally to protecting your anonymity. During the course of transcription all <u>direct identifiers</u> (names, addresses,

employment, streets, etc.) and <u>indirect identifiers</u> (workplace, organisations) will be <u>removed</u> or <u>changed</u>.

Local elections, an up-coming general election, economic worries, climate change, the future of public services, personal and national security...

At the start of the 21st century, Britain faces many challenges. The aim of this research is to talk to people about current events and issues and learn more about what people think about the challenges facing Britain.

What do I have to do?

Just talk and give your views.

The focus groups will consist of 5 to 10 other people and will be led by a moderator. You will first be asked to fill out a brief questionnaire. In order to get a good cross-section of the public not everyone who applies will be invited to participate in the focus groups, however you might be invited to participate in a one-on-one interview instead.

There will another focus group after the next general election which will review many of these topics again. If you are invited to the first focus group you may participate in the post-election focus group, and will again be eligible for £25 in participant compensation.

The focus group will take place at a location convenient for you. It will be recorded with a digital video recorder and transcribed.

The transcripts will be analysed to better understand the views of Britons today.
