

## METADATA FOR THE ISAAC CORE QUESTIONNAIRE DATA FILES (PHASES ONE &amp; THREE)

This file provides essential information required to accurately read archived ISAAC Phase One and Phase Three core (symptom) questionnaire data files.

The data for each participant occupies one line.

There are no column headers.
