Background

Public Health England (PHE) has commissioned The Diet and Health Study 2014, under the contract of the National Diet and Nutrition Study (P10041.08), to monitor progress towards the dietary target to reduce salt intake to approximately 6g per day. The study will be carried out in England and Scotland with adults, aged 19-64. Consumption of dietary sodium (or salt) is related to high blood pressure and cardiovascular disease. Sodium consumption can be assessed by measuring its levels in urine.

Individuals will be recruited by the Telephone Unit (TU) and details of those agreeing to take part will be passed onto nurses. Respondents will be asked to collect all urine passed during a 24-hour period.

Fieldwork will be carried out in six monthly waves: TU carry out recruitment in March – August. Nurse appointments will be carried out May - September. In that time we aim to collect usable urine samples from 600 adults.

Factsheet

 household information and information for each individual session. All questions

 recorded alongside the appropriate questions or at the end of the FACTSHEET, if the
 question has not been printed.
- All soft checks that were triggered by the nurse and which have not been resolved will
 trigger again in the edit program. Where appropriate these should be investigated. If
 no editing action can be taken to resolve these checks, they should be cancelled by
 the editor.

Please record all information on the fact sheets including:

- The screen number of the question requiring coding
- The actual code given to each question that requires backcoding
- How a remark has been dealt with
