General Household Survey Codebook

Introduction

The General Household Survey is a continuous multi-purpose national sample survey based on private households selected from the Electoral Register. It originated in 1971 as a service to various government departments (see GHS, Introductory Report, chap 1).

Departmental interests change, and therefore although there is substantial continuity in questions over time, new areas for questioning are introduced, eg. leisure in 1973 and 1977, and drinking in 1978, and the form of questions varies between years (see summary of questionnaire content of the GHS from 1971 to 1978 in GHS, 1978, Appendix C).

Sample Design

The sample remained largely unchanged between 1971 and 1974 and was designed to be representative of Great Britain in each calendar quarter. The 3-stage sample design involved the selection of 168 Local Authority areas as the primary sampling units (PSUs) by probability proportional to population size, after first stratifying Local Authority areas by (a) regions (b) conurbations; other urban areas; semi-rural areas; and rural areas, and (c) average rateable value. Each year 4 wards (in rural areas, groups of parishes) are selected from each PSU with probability proportional to population size. The selected Local Authority areas are rotated such that a quarter are replaced every 3 months. Within each ward, 20 or 25 addresses are selected. A maximum of 3 households are interviewed at each address (and to compensate for additional households at an address a corresponding number are deleted from the interviewer's address list). This yielded a total effective sample of 15,360 households in 1973. (See full discussion of sampling, response rates and sampling errors in GHS, Introductory Report chap. 3 and

GHS, 1973, chap 1).

Since 1975, in an attempt to reduce the effects of clustering, the sample design has been based on a 2-stage sampling procedure with electoral wards as the PSUs. Geographically contiguous wards or parishes are grouped where necessary to provide a minimum electorate of 2,300 before selection. Wards are stratified by (a) regions (b) metropolitan and non-metropolitan counties, and (c) percentage in higher or intermediate non-manual socio-economic groups, to produce 168 strata. Within these strata wards are listed by (d) percentage of households in owner occupation, before being systematically selected by probability proportional to size. Four wards are used from each stratum each year, with each selected ward in use for 3 years before being replaced. Selection of addresses within wards remains the same as before 1975, but addresses where there are multiple households are treated somewhat differently (see 1975 chap.

1). Each quarterly sample is independent and still nationally representative.

Response Rates:- Some households respond only partially, therefore

response rates can be measured in a number of different ways:-

1. The minimum response rate, defined as only completely co-operating households - 70% in 1973.
2. The maximum response rate, excludes only households where the

whole household either refused or was not contacted - 84% in 1973.

3. The middle response rate, includes households where information is missing for certain questions, but excludes those where information is missing altogether for one or more household member - 81% in 1973.

The middle response rate therefore includes the 6% (in 1973) of households in which information about one or more household member was obtained from someone else in the household (a 'proxy'). Certain questions are not asked by proxy, eg. questions on income, educational qualifications and opinion.

Sampling Error:- A multi-stage sample design results in sampling

errors that are almost always larger than for an equivalent sample size selected by simple random sampling (SRS). Therefore, it is misleading to use sampling errors calculated on the basis of SRS. The net effect of a more complex sample design is the ratio of the true sampling error to that calculated using the SRS formula, and is called the design effect.

The size of the design effect depends on the particular variable under investigation. Some variables, such as age of house, are affected more by clustering and have a higher design effect than other variables, such as health status, which has a design effect close to 1.00. Design effects were computed for a selection of variables using 1971 data (see GHS, Introductory Report, chap 3) and

fuller details of the calculation of sampling errors and design effects are given in chap 7, GHS, 1972.

Structure of Data Files

The GHS data have been prepared as (1) an SPSS data file, and (2) an SPSS program file containing variable names, variable labels, value labels and missing values in accordance with SPSS conventions (see Nie et. al, 1975). The data set is based on individuals (ie. all adults and children in the sample households); that is, the case unit is an individual, not a household. Information about the

household, eg. age of house, housing costs, and housing amenities, which was collected from one adult on the Household Schedule, has been duplicated for every member of the household.

Household information:- The GHS defines a household as 'a group of people living regularly at one address, who are all catered for by the same person for at least one meal a day'. Information relating to the household (eg. age of house) is common to all individuals living in the household, and is therefore duplicated for all household members (for instance, the value of the response to the variable AGEHOUSE will be the same for all members of one household).

Duplicated information about Head of Household:- Each household has a 'head of household' who, in order of precedence, is defined as the husband of the person, or the person who, either owns the household accommodation or is legally responsible for the rent of the accommodation. Most heads of household will therefore be male.

It is often useful to relate information about the head of household (HOH) to information about other members of the household, eg. to

analyse health of children by socio-economic group (SEG) of the head of household. To this end, information about the HOH has been duplicated for all household members, eg. HOHSEG - indicates the socio-economic group of the HOH; HOHHEDQ - the highest educational qualifications of HOH; and HOHINCEM - the total annual income of HOH. (HOHSEG, for instance, duplicates the SEG of the head of household for all members of the household, so that if the head of household's SEG was 12 (skilled manual) and there were three others living in the household then the value of HOHSEG will be 12 for all these four individuals.)

Family Units and Duplicated Information for Husband and Wife:- A

number of family units may live in the same household. A family unit may consist of a husband and wife and their children, provided the children are unmarried or have no children of their own; it may also be a lone parent with unmarried children. A household containing 2 unmarried sisters living together would consist of 2 family units, while an elderly woman living with her unmarried daughter would constitute a single family unit. If, however, the unmarried daughter had a child, then the household would consist of two family units. In family units including a husband and wife, certain information relating to the husband and the wife has been duplicated for all members of the family unit. For example, HUSSEG

and WIFSEG provide information on the socio-economic group (SEG) of husband and wife respectively for all members of the family unit. If, for instance, the husband was in SEG 12 and the wife in SEG 9

(junior non-manual) then the value of HUSSEG would be 12 and the value of WIFSEG would be 9 for all members of the family unit.

Cross-link variables:- Variables created from information about

others in the household or family unit and duplicated for all household (or family unit) members can be recognised because they begin with HOH..., HUS... or WIF.... In addition, a number of other variables have been duplicated for all household (or family unit) members. These include: NPERHH, NCHILDHH, NPERFAM, NCHLDFAM, NMARFAM, TOTCHRON, TOTSMOKE, MVINCFU, TOTINCFU, MVINCHH and TOTINCHH.

Derived Variables

In some cases the variables which are obtained from the GHS are not ideal for analysis. A number of new variables has therefore been created to simplify certain types of analysis. For instance, HEDQUAL - highest educational qualifications, is derived from the variables ANYQUAL, Q1TYPE, Q2TYPE, Q3TYPE, HQ1TYPE, HQ2TYPE, and HQ3TYPE (Education Section, Qu. 9) which together give all the qualifications obtained by the individual; and TOTINCID - the individual's total income, is derived from the 11 possible sources of income given in the Income Section, Question 1. These derived variables are provided in addition to the original GHS data. The variables from which they have been calculated remain in the data set, except where no information has been lost by creating a new variable, eg. SEG (the individual's socio-economic group) combines information on current occupation for those working (Employment Section, Qu. 3), last occupation for those no longer working (Qu. 25b), and main occupation during life for the retired (Qu. 26).

Deleted Variables

Almost all the data collected by GHS has been retained, but a few variables have been omitted. In omitting variables the following criteria have been used:-

1. When a section of questions has only been asked occasionally, eg. the Leisure Section in 1973, and the questions on medicine taking in 1973 (Health Section, Qu 1).
2. Where a few individuals engage in a particular activity many times, a cut-off frequency has been chosen. The number specified aims to minimise the loss of cases without excessively enlarging the size of the data set. For example, a variable was created indicating the total number of contacts with general practitioners (GPs) in the 2 week reference period, but variables providing details about only the first two contacts with GPs have been retained for 1973 and for the first four contacts in subsequent years.

Continuous variables

Some variables in the GHS include a large number of answer categories. Where these are at the interval level of measurement, eg. income, rateable value and age, they have been left in this form in the SPSS data file. However, for ease of reference in the codebook, these 'continuous' variables have been recoded into grouped categories so that the approximate frequencies can be ascertained. It is important to remember that the categories in the codebook for 'continuous' variables are not included in the data file, but that the data has been left in its original continuous form.

Missing Values

In the SPSS data file and in the codebook, certain categories of variables are defined as MISSING, eg. category 9 on LIVRES, categories -9 and -1 on RENTFROM. This means that during an SPSS procedure, the missing categories will be automatically excluded from the analysis, unless you specify as an OPTION that you wish these values to be included.

Household Structure

Two variables have been derived to describe the composition of the household. The first, HHTYPE, is described in the Codebook and is based on the Department of the Environment's classification of the 'type' of household. The second variable, HHSTRUCT, provides an alternative measure of the composition of the household, based on the relationships of household members to the 'head of household'. Both variables are duplicated for each member of the household.

There are 6 possible codes, 1, 2, 4, 8, 16, and 32, each of which indicates the presence of particular relationships within the household.

1. child(ren) under 16.
2. unmarried adult(s) without own child(ren).
i.e. family units containing only one person.
4. single parent - i.e. unmarried with child(ren).
8. married couple.
16. grandparent(s) of others in the household - a 3-

generational household.

32. person(s) aged 60 or over - 'retired'.

The six codes are used additively so that any one of the 63 possible combinations indicates unambiguously a particular household structure. When interpreting the variable it is important to remember that structure is in relation to the head of household.

Examples.

Thus category (1) does not contain children who are living on their

own, but marks a household where the head of household is living with children under 16 but is neither their parent nor grand-parent and where there are no other persons in the household. This explains the absence of any entries in category (4) - single parent - because, by definition, a single parent is only so categorised when they are living with a child of their own; they would, therefore, fall into category (5) which is derived by summing (1) and (4). Category (9) contains the largest numbers as it represents the 'traditional' nuclear family - a married couple with one or more children under 16 - the sum of relationships (8) and (1). Category (0) contains those household types which do not fall into any of the above categories. It represents a household containing no children under 16, no single parent, no married couple and no one of 60 or more. An example of such a household is that containing a widowed woman of less than 60 and her unmarried son who is over 16. Because they are classified as a single family unit they do not fall into category 2.

Variable: PERNO INDIVIDUAL NO. FOR EACH PERSON IN H-HOLD

Household Schedule, p.1.

The questions in the Household Schedule are answered by one member of the household, usually the head of household. Some of the information is individual for each member of the household, e.g.sex,age, and some is common to members of the family unit, rather than the household. Sometimes information is common to the members of a moving group e.g.MOVEMAIN. Most sections of the Household Schedule contain information which is common to all members of the household and is replicated for each individual.

A person number is allocated to each individual in the household. Person 1 is always the Head of Household, but other person numbers are assigned arbitrarily to others in the household.
